Park Dedication: The date for the Dedication is set for August 28, 2021. Gerry will report the plan at the next meeting.

Main Street Program: Heidi volunteered to look at List Serve for possibilities for a volunteer to help us get started with the Main Street Program. She will look at smaller cities and explore summer intern programs for us.

City Signs: Connie reported that the signs are being worked on to make the suggested change to them.

Fire Hydrant Project: We discussed that we should let our neighbors know what we are doing with the hydrants. Heidi said she would do this. Gerry will find out what kind of paint to use on hydrants and get quotes for it. Kristi is going to talk to Hazelnut Growers to see if they would like to sponsor us and the possibility of using their "hazelnut" logo for the project. This part has not been fully decided yet. We looked at the flyer and entry forms as well as Krista and her girls' other research.

Planter Project: Connie is talking to people she knows to see about flowers for the planters and Heidi is looking into getting the dirt for them. We decided we will go ahead with the dirt and get it in the planters and GK will move the planters into their final locations when we are ready. We need to decide where we should put them on Main Street.

Corner of Butteville and Main Street: Gerry will bring drawings of plans for this area for viewing. She is also looking into signage for people entering the city and where to go. It will be like a pole kiosk. She will bring quotes for this as well.

Donald Tree City: Arbor Week in Donald is going to be April 18-21, 2021. Mayor Olmsted is doing a proclamation for the city and the Tree Board has done a lot of work organizing this week for our city. They have some virtual classes for all of us to watch. Painting of the DCC: We discussed colors for the newly sided DCC, and we looked at some paint samples. Gerry said she would get samples so that we can try them on the siding, and we will be deciding on the colors of choice for this project.

Art Grant: We also discussed a community living grant. Suggestions for this could be to paint the basketball court for pickleball as well, benches for Main Street and a cement ping pong table were also discussed. Gerry is looking at benches and will be getting prices. We will need to decide where to place the benches.
