Connie met with The Tire Factory and ordered the tires and sizes we need. They will be delivered to the GK Machine yard to be cleaned and treated as needed and then will be painted. They fill the tires or stack the tires on sand to anchor them. Gerry suggested that perhaps on how the park land cover goes we may be able to recycle the sand that is at the park now.

Connie, Heidi, Alonso and I had a short meeting and have determined how the "Tireland" will be situated. It was determined that we will move the 6' cyclone fence over towards city hall. Consensus was that we will leave about 6' between the city hall and the fence.
