a. Revisions to City Mission Statement

c. & d. Revisit/Revisions to 2019 City Goals & Creation of 2020 Goals

They also updated the priorities numbering system: a rating of a "3" now means desirable and a "4" rating was removed. They also worked to set priorities numbers for the goals, updating some based on the progress made. They also changed some of the dates for projects to be completed, based on progress made or because they have more information about the subject matter now than they did when they assigned the date. Throughout the review process, they edited some of the particular goal's language for clarity but no new goals were added. There were edits to the objectives by adding some, editing for language to add clarity, and eliminating some because they were completed.
