**Baby Time:**

**Park News:**

We will be going through the names submitted for the Park at the next meeting. Gerry will put together a list of all the submissions and bring to the meeting.

**Grant Money:**

We were awarded an \$1180 Grant for economic development. We discussed ideas about how to use the money. Planters were mentioned by Connie and she volunteered to research costs.

We also talked about painting the fire hydrants and Krista, and Naomi will be researching this idea.

Connie brought up the Kiosk idea again. Heidi said that Gloria wouldn't have the money from her grant for the Kiosk so we will be looking into this project. Gloria was unable to make the meeting so we will discuss next meeting when Gloria can be there.

### Sidewalk Project:

Heidi reported that the first invoices were sent out for payment. This is for the month of August.

### Clean Up Day:

Heidi said that our budget is \$2200. We will be getting 2 dumpsters and 1 yard debris container. We'll also be collecting batteries and glass. Instead of taking meds the sheriff will be giving out something that we can take home to dissolve our meds and put in garbage. It's a new way of disposal. It will be held in the GK Parking lot which Mike believes will be a better space for distancing. People will be asked to unload their own stuff. If they can't do it, they will be asked to stay in vehicle while we unload. We will collect a donation or they can drop off at city hall.

There will be no curb service this year. It will be from 8-12 noon or until dumpsters are full.
