The Rules and Directions:

Overall, in order to make this work safely and in accordance with COVID-19 guidelines, there are a few rules that will to have to followed:

- All vehicles and/or machinery that is entered into the parade must have insurance. The City of Donald is not liable for any damages or collisions to your vehicle that occur during the event, including any damange caused by other participants. You are participating at your own risk.
- No pedestrians, bicycles, skateboards, or other like modes of transportation. Entires must be motorized.
- The vehicle has to be decorated for the holidays. No political entries. Décor can be lights, tinsel, aminated animals/people, people in costumes, music, or simply flashing lights on your vehicle.
- We will have our own vehicle ready for Santa when he arrives from the North Pole for the Parade. Please **DO NOT have a Santa ride in your vehicle as well**. It might be concerning to children if he appeared more than once. Lets keep the magic alive!
- No throwing/giving anything to observers. This is for two reasons 1) it will be dark and we don't want to entice children into the streets where there will be heavy machinery and large vehicles driving. 2) To meet COVID-19 regulations and minimize contamination.
- Please maintain social distancing and stay at least 6 feet from people outside of your household group.
 Please stay in your vehicle or on your machinery. If you need to make adjustments to your lights and/or décor then do so and then get back in your vehicle. Please do not socialize with others outside of your household group.
- Please help keep our City Staff and volunteers safe. When talking to a City Employee or Donald Beautification Group volunteer (or anyone outside your household group) you *must wear a* face covering. While in your vehicle with your household group you may remove your face covering.
- The parade will move less than 5mph and go through as many streets as possible excluding dead-end streets due to the logistics of getting large vehicles/machinery turned around easily.
- Keep a minimum distance of 6ft from the vehicle in front of you.
- The parade route will be released on December 15th.
- Participants must continue in the parade until it is over. This will ensure that all observers get to enjoy the parade in it's entirety!
- When you arrive, please get in line. A volunteer will have the end of the line "lit up" for you to see.
- Please refrain from smoking or vaping during the parade.
