

RESOLUTION No. 486-19

A RESOLUTION TO ADOPTING THE CITY COUNCIL AND PLANNING COMMISSION GOALS

WHEREAS, the Council desired to review the City Council and Planning Commission's Goals and Objectives for the purpose of visioning and to recognize the recent accomplishments; and

WHEREAS, the City's leadership places high value on having City goals to give clear direction regarding the City's priorities and vision for the elected leaders, appointed officials, city staff, volunteers and residents and businesses to follow; and
